The WMO released "The State of Climate in Asia 2021" on November 14, 2022.

The report summarizes the climate and extreme weather events of 2021 and their associated socioeconomic impacts in Asian region (RA II), continuing from last year's report which was the first issue.

TCC cooperated with lead authors to contribute by preparing and going through drafts of the manuscripts. In the process, various reports and observed data by National Meteorological and Hydrological Services (NMHSs) and WMO Regional Climate Centers (RCCs) in this region were very useful. We would like to thank all of NMHSs and RCCs in this region.

Finally, we hope that the report will be utilized in various fields to recognize the current status of the climate situation in this region and we will support this kind of activity continuously.
